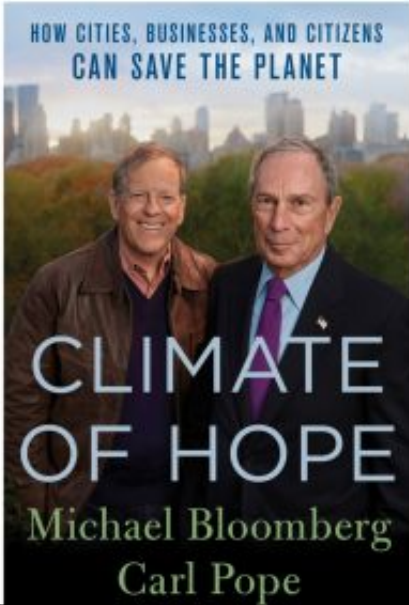


# Book Review—"Climate of Hope: How Cities, Businesses, and Citizens Can Save The Planet"
